Masters and school owners,

Please let me introduce myself. I am the coordinator for the martial arts program at Minnesota International University. We have developed a Bachelor's of Art degree program that features a specialization in Taekwondo or Haidong Gumdo.

The full degree program is listed above. It is a full business degree that will provide the opportunity to gain knowledge for operating your business. Additionally, it provides an academic recognition for the years of work that you've dedicated your life to.

The importance of this program is that these are three credit academic courses and not merely one credit activity classes. If you currently have a 2<sup>nd</sup> Dan rank or higher, you will have the availability to "test out" of the eight courses as you work toward your degree.

This brings me to the tuition. As you are receiving this letter, I have had contact with you. The importance of this is that I have been permitted to arrange reduced price tuition for a limited time. The standard cost is \$300/credit but, as a way to help each other out, MIU will reduce the cost to \$150/credit for the entire degree program. This will help make the "test out" and online availability much more accessible.

MIU is currently the only university in the nation that has martial arts courses as three credit offerings. The degrees are recognized by the Minnesota Office of Higher Education. The accreditation of the degrees, while completely voluntary, is being applied for. This is a full academic degree, which is not to be confused with unregistered organizations using the term university, college or academy in their names.
