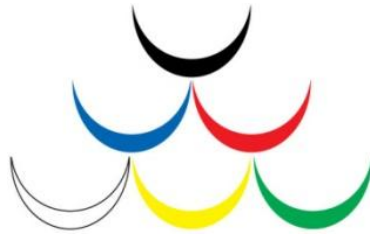

GENERAL RULES

- [1] This tournament is governed by the championship rules and guidelines of the World Haidong Gumdo® Federation and is only open to current members of the the World Haidong Gumdo® Federation.
- [2] All competitors must wear a complete Haidong Gumdo® uniform with authorized markings only (no visible clothing under the dobok).
- [3] Instructors participating in the bamboo cutting competition are required to wear white martial arts shoes during the bamboo cutting competition. For all other divisions, wearing shoes during the competition will result in disqualification (in case an exception is required due to medical circumstances, please consult one of the judges prior to the competition).
- [4] At the beginning and ending of each performance, the competitor bows to the judges with the sword out of the belt. This applies to all divisions.
- [5] Etiquette is of utmost importance within Haidong Gumdo®. In the event that a competitor shows bad etiquette, this may result in deduction of points or disqualification.
- [6] Note that in all divisions, male and female competitors may be combined. We reserve the right to combine or add divisions to best accommodate everyone.
- [7] Competitors will be assigned to a division based on **Dan promotions until May 31st, 2016**. *Example: promoted to 1st Dan on Jun 5th, 2016 means this competitor will compete in the Color Belt [GohGeup] division.*
- [8] Competitors will be assigned to a division based on their **age as of July 22nd, 2016**.
- [9] In case of a tie, competition will be repeated.
- [10] Championship rules may be visualized by video footage.

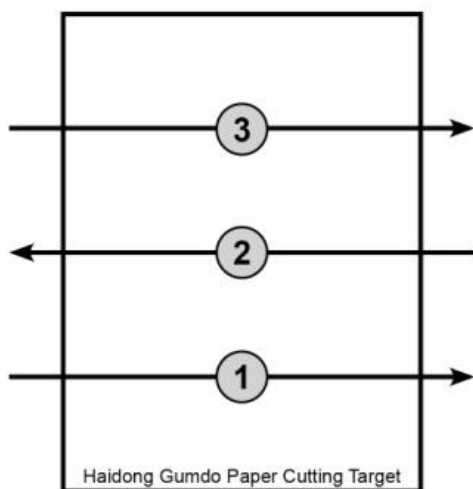
INDIVIDUAL GUMBUB	
Color Belts Level 1	<u>Main and Final:</u> Ssangsoo Gumbub No. 1 + 2 performed continuously. - Mokgum
Color Belts Level 2	<u>Main and Final:</u> Ssangsoo Gumbub No. 2 + 4 performed continuously. - Mokgum
Black Belts [1st Dan]	<u>Main and Final:</u> SsangSoo Gumbub No. 7 + 8 performed continuously. - Gagum
Black Belts [2nd Dan]	<u>Main and Final:</u> Simsang Gumbub - Gagum
Instructors [3rd Dan+]	<u>Main and Final:</u> Yedo Gumbub No. 2 + 3 performed continuously - Gagum
Masters	<u>Main and Final:</u> Yedo Gumbub No. 5 + 6 performed continuously - Gagum
<p>Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * For all rounds: NO Chakgum in between. Only upon finishing all the Gumbubs. * All Gumbubs should start facing the front; towards the judge table. * The competitor may freely create the transitions between the different Gumbubs <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. "Junbi" command → repeat with a loud "Junbi!" 2. "Sijak" command → start the gumbub with a loud "Gihab!" 3. Chakgum is performed individually upon finishing all two gumbubs. <p><u>Competitors will be judged, based on the following points:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Speed : correct stance and balance while moving fast • Power : correct stance and sword line while making powerful cuts • Accuracy : correct focus of the eyes, stance and sword line 	

PAPER CUTTING	
Color Belts Level 1	Main: 2 cut [①left, ②right] - highest score (4 people) Final: 2 cuts [①left, ②right] - highest score
Color Belts Level 2	Main: 2 cut [①left, ②right] - highest score (4 people) Final: 2 cuts [①left, ②right] - highest score
Black Belts [1st Dan]	Main: 2 cuts [①left, ②right] - highest score (4 people) Final: 3 cuts [①left, ②right, ③left] - highest score
Black Belts [2nd Dan]	Main: 2 cuts [①left, ②right] - highest score (4 people) Final: 3 cuts [①left, ②right, ③left] - highest score
Instructors and Masters	Final: 3 cuts [①left, ②right, ③left] - highest score (4 people)

Stand in front of the paper cutting target with the cutting sword against your belt.

1. "**Junbi**" command → repeat with a loud "**junbi!**"
2. "**Baldo**" command → draw the sword (loud "**Gihab**") into "**Jayeon Kyeonjeokse**"
3. "**Sijak**" command → step into "**kimase**" and make the first cut
4. Stop for a short moment after the cut.
5. Upon turning the swords direction, **immediately** make the next cut
6. After the last cut, step back into "**Jayeon Kyeonjeokse**" and sheath the sword
7. No points will be given for the cut if :
 - the paper is not completely cut
 - the cut enters the dark grey area
 - the cut is performed with one hand
8. Disqualification: if the paper is hit away and falls of its suspension or if after the cut one side of the paper is hit away and a piece of paper is still hanging on the suspension.

Cutting order



*** The Official WHGF Paper Cutting Target will be used

- Paper size (Width 50cm * Height 78cm) /
 - The height of each score section is 1.5cm
 - Total of 46 sections. 46 * 1.5cm = 69cm
- The remaining space of the paper does not count for scoring.

Paper cutting sword will be prepared

Use of **own sword** is allowed

Fed. sword mandatory

Bamboo Cutting	
Black Belts [Women]	Main: 1 Pole 2 cuts - ①left↘, ②right↙ - highest score (4 people) Final: 1 Pole 3 cuts - ①left↘, ②right↙, ③left↗
Black Belts [Men]	Main: 1 Pole 3 cuts - ①left↘, ②right↙, ③left↗ - highest score (4 people) Final: 2 Poles 5 cuts - ①right↙, ②left↘, (turn 540° to the right), ③left↘, ④right↙, ⑤left↗
Instructors & Masters	Final: 2 Poles 5 cuts - ①right↙, ②left↘, (turn 540° to the right), ③left↘, ④right↙, ⑤left↗

Stand in front of the bamboo with the sword in your belt, held in your left hand.

1. "Junbi" command → repeat with a loud "Junbi!"
2. "Baldo" command → draw the sword (loud "Gihab!") into "Jayeon Kyeonjeokse"
3. "Sijak" command → start the cuts
4. After the last cut, step back into "Jayeon Kyeonjeokse" and sheath the sword

- Main Round** - Black belts [Women]: 2 successful cut in order to go to the next round
 - Black belts [Men]: 3 successful cuts in order to go to the next round
 - Instructors and Masters: 3 successful cuts in order to go to the next round

Final Round - Drop-out system until 4 people with the highest score remain → winners

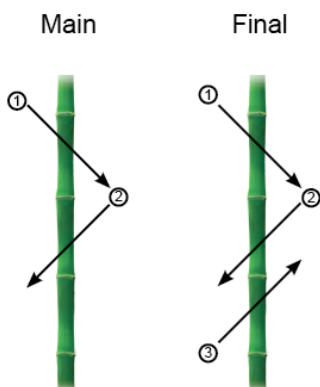

* **Final Round:** Each successful cut is worth 10 points. No points will be given for the **cut** if:

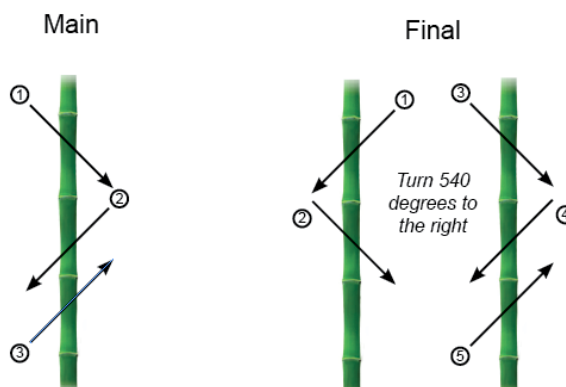
- the bamboo is not completely cut or split into parts
- there are remainders after the cut
- the bamboo is launched out of its seat

In the event that the bamboo pole falls down, no points will be given for all the cuts that were to follow. *Example:* ① = good cut (10 points); ② = bamboo pole falls down (0 points); ③ = (0 points).

INDIVIDUAL SWORD DANCE	
<p>All Level All Ages</p>	<p>Mandatory techniques (<i>points will be deducted if not included in the performance</i>)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Performance with the sword in Right hand reverse for more than 10 seconds 2. 3 continuous turning (hwejeon) motions to left side then immediately 3 continuous turning to the right side.
<p>- One round: Final</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Music must be prepared individually - Performance without cutting (e.g. bamboo or straw) - Duration of performance & music: Minimum 2 minutes and Maximum 3 minutes (music will stop after 3 minutes) - Free choice of uniform, music and material (fan, cloth, weapons, etc. may only be used for a maximum of 30 seconds)

<p>* The first Gumbub out of the three should start facing the front; towards the jury table</p> <p>* Square formation</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. "Junbi" command → repeat with a loud "junbi!" 2. "Sijak" command → start the Gumbub with a loud "kihap!" 3. Chakgum is performed individually upon finishing all three Gumbubs. <p><u>The group will be judged, based on the following points:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Speed : correct stance and balance while moving fast • Power : correct stance and sword line while making powerful cuts • Accuracy : correct focus of the eyes, stance and sword line • Harmony : 4 persons performing the Gumbub synchronously <p>Black Belts: Federation Gagum mandatory</p>	

GROUP PAPER CUTTING (6 persons)	
All Level All Ages	One round: Final: Each Competitor has 2 [①left, ②right]
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - One round: Final - Each competitor's score will be added for a total team amount; the team with the highest result wins - score of disqualified competitors will not be added to the team result - Same rules apply to group paper cut as for individual paper cut - Instructors and Masters may participate <p> paper cutting sword will be prepared Use of own sword is allowed Federation paper cutting sword mandatory </p>	

GROUP SWORD DANCE	
All Level All Ages	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - One round: Final - Group consisting of minimum 6 persons and maximum 15 persons - Anyone of any rank, gender or age can participate - Music must be prepared individually (CD, USB etc.) - Performance without cutting (e.g. bamboo or straw) - Maximum duration of performance & music: 3 minutes (music will stop after 3 minutes) - Free choice of uniform, music and material - Instructors and Masters may participate <p> <u>Competitors will be judged, based on the following points:</u> </p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Creativity Technique Harmony Teamwork
